### Judy Knighton, RN, M.Sc.N.

Judy Knighton is the Clinical Nurse Specialist – Burns in the Ross Tilley Burn Centre at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre, Toronto. She also holds a Clinical Appointee position, Graduate School Division, Faculty of Nursing, University of Toronto, and is president and founder of **Burn Resource Centre Inc.**, a consulting company

She received her Master of Science in Nursing degree from the University of Toronto in 1982 and her Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree from that same university in 1979. Her 31 years of burn experience include pediatric and adult burn patients and their families in critical, acute, rehabilitative and community settings at The Hospital for Sick Children, Toronto General Hospital, The Wellesley Hospital and Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre. She also directed both the Skin and Wound and Pain Management programs at The Wellesley Hospital.

In addition to lecturing and consulting across Canada and in the United States, Judy is a past-president and one of the founding members of the Canadian Association of Burn Nurses, and a member of the Nursing Committee of the International Society for Burn Injuries. She is also the nurse assessor for Plastic Surgery Independent Health Facilities for the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.
